to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto *Robert C. Lytle*

First; All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, on the South side of Park Avenue, in the County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of the N. C. Cleveland property according to a plat of record in the S. M. C. Office for Updegraff County in Plat Book 9, at page 26, and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on South side of Park Avenue, 132 feet from southwest corner of Park Avenue and Lanes Street; thence N. 76 1/2 W. with Park Avenue, 64 feet to stake, corner of Lot No. 4; thence with line of lot No. 4 in a southerly direction 182 feet, thence to a rock wall, cross line; thence with said rock wall S. 88 E. 65 feet to line of Lot No. 2; thence with line of Lot No. 2 in a northeasterly direction, 170 feet to the beginning.

Also: All that other piece or parcel of land adjoining the above described property on the South, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake along the line of lots owned by N.
