the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nannie C. Pinson

"all that certain lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the American Spinning Company, and being designated as Lot No. 4 on a plat made by W. A. Hudson, recorded in Deed Book N. N. N. Page 485, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat.
