NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and no/100 (100.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said B.I.T. Corporation,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said B.I.T. Corporation, the following described real estate, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Rose Avenue and being known and designated as lot no 16, Block 4, of Chapin Springs Land Company, the plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 6, page 4, and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on Rose Avenue, which iron pin is distant in an easterly direction 250 feet from the intersection of the northern line of Rose Avenue with the eastern line of Houston Street, and in the corner of Lot no 17, Block 5, and running thence with Rose Avenue N. 88° 6' 50" feet to corner of lot no 15, Block 4, thence with line of said lot no 15, N. 26° 21'. 150" feet to iron pin joint to corner of lots 4, 5, 15 and 16, Block 4, thence with the back line of lot no 4, S. 88° 21'. 50" feet to joint corner of lots 3, 4, 16 and 17, thence with line of lot no 17, S. 2° 0' 8. 150" feet to beginning corner on Rose Avenue.
