TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$150.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, a corporation under the laws of South Carolina,the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, a corporation

"All that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, fronting on Wilkins Street, and having the following lines and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Wilkins Street, and running thence along the same N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 96 links to a stake; thence N. 30 E. 1.92 chains to a stake on an alley; thence S. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 2.14 chains to a stake; thence S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.55 chains to the beginning corner, containing one fourth (1/4) of an acre, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to said Paul Sweeney by Payne Webster, November 17, 1919."
