I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, R. W. Matheny

on or about the 21st day of July, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Gertrude B. Agnew, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 20th day of August, 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said T. A. Roe

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. A. Roe

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid, about two and one-half miles from Greenville Court-house, known as lot No. 62 and half of lot No. 63 on plat of Shannon Terrace, as made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, Jan. 1930, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following mates and bounds, according to said plat:

Beginning at a stake corner of Lot No. 61 and running thence with Brookview Circle S. 31 E. 60 feet to a stake; thence continuing with Brookview Circle S. 51 E. 25 feet to stake corner of Lot No. 63; thence S. 39 W. 334 feet to stake in line of property of Frank Earle; thence S. 89-80 W. with the line of the property of Frank Earle 54.3 feet; thence N. 38-46 W. 134.8 to a stake; thence N. 57.06 W. 350 feet to the beginning corner, said premises being that conveyed to Gertrude B.
