the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said Belle B. Hunt

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South  
Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the East side  
of Spring Street, having the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at a point on the East side of  
Spring Street at the corner of a 12-foot alley, which  
point is 99 feet north of the northeast intersection of  
Spring Street and East Washington Street and running  
thence with said alley, S. 71<sup>o</sup> 64 feet, more or less, to
