all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, on the
eastern side of Georgia Avenue, being a portion of Lot I-2
as shown on plat of property of "West Highland", made by
W. D. Nevis, C. E., in February, 1916, recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at Page 258, and
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the eastern side of Georgia
Avenue 396 feet south from Easley Bridge Road, corner of
lot now or formerly owned by J. G. Eppes, and running
thence with the line of his lot, N. 71 E. 166 feet, more or
less, to a stake in line of the right-of-way of the P. & N.
Railroad; thence with the line of said right-of-way S.
11 E. 157 feet to a stake, corner of Lot I-1; thence with the
line of said lot, S. 71 W. 162.4 feet to a stake on Georgia
Avenue; thence with the eastern side of Georgia Avenue
N. 9.30 W. 157 feet to the beginning corner.
