all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

with the following metes and bounds according to plat of the estate of J. H. Oldams made by W. J. Riddell, Surveyor, October 18, 1933, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the Laurens Road at the corner of property now or formerly of J. Y. Knight and running thence S. 132.15. W. 226 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots one and two; thence S. 31.15 E. 100 feet to a point joint corner of lots one, two and three; thence along the joint line of lots two and three N. 56.30 E. 220 feet to a point in the Laurens Road; thence N. 31.15 W. 110 feet to the beginning corner. Said lot being known as lot No. 2 on the said plat, being bounded by lot No. 1, lot No. 3, Laurens Road and property now or formerly of J. Y. Knight.
