All of my right title and interest in and that two certain lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots 70 and 71, property of the Colonia Company, the same fronting 60 feet each on Franklin Road with a depth of 300 feet as shown on plat recorded in P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "4" at page 112.

This deed is executed in pursuance of the authority contained in the will of Mrs. Annie I. Goodlett dated September 27, 1922 and filed in the office of the Probate Judge in Apartment 187, File 17.
