

TITLE TO REALESTATE

1. To take possession of any and all lands, buildings, tenements, or other structures, or any part, or parts, thereof, in which we have an interest under the last will and testament of Frank H. Irvine, deceased, dated February 20, 1929, and filed in the office of the Probate Court for the County and State aforesaid;

2. To ask for, sue for, collect and receive, any rents, profits, or income, of any and all of said lands, buildings, tenements, or other structures, or of any part, or parts, thereof;

Generally to do, execute and perform any other act, matter, or thing, whatsoever, that, in the opinion of our said attorney, ought to be done, executed or performed, in and about the premises, as fully as we, the said Annie May Jones-Williams, Marion Jones-Williams and Irvine Jones-Williams, could do, if personally present.

And we, the said Annie May Jones-Williams, Marion Jones-Williams and Irvine Jones-Williams, do hereby ratify and confirm all that our said attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue hereof.
