Batson, Delinquent Tax Collector for the City of Greenville, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the sum of Three and 97/100 Dollars, have granted, bargained, sold and released and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said City of Greenville, S. C., its successors.

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot No. 3 of Block "B" according to a survey and plat of the estates of J. W. Cagle and W. L. Mauldin as traced and restaked by W. D. Neves, Engineer, on April 5th, 1919, said plat being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" page 107. Said lot having a frontage of 70 feet on Meadow Street and a depth of 100 feet.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said City of Greenville, S. C. its successors heirs and assigns forever.
