"All that certain lot or parcel of land lying and being situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known as the Western portion of the Bud-Obe Davenport place, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone N. W. corner Davington Church lot and running thence along road N. 0-06 W. 19.35 to iron pin; thence N. 80-40 E.
