P. F. Cuttino, his heirs and assigns, forever;

All our undivided two-thirds interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land near Paris Station, in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 5.96 acres, more or less, according to plat of estate of J. H. Ballenger, made in 1933 and revised in July 1938, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of McCarters Shop Road and thence down the center of said road N. 235 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-30 E. 1320 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of T. E. Green land S. 19-0 W. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-50 W. 1247 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

Also all our undivided two-thirds interest in and to that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate near Paris Station, Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, facing 407.2 feet on Lee Road, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat of J. H. Ballenger estate made in 1933 and revised in July 1938.

Beginning at an iron pin on Lee Road, joint corner of William H. Cuttino property, and running down said road N. 74-13 W. 407.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5-35 W. 357.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-30 E. 366.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 12-30 E. 351 feet, to the beginning corner.

This deed is made for the purpose of partitioning the real estate owned in common by the grantors and grantee herein.

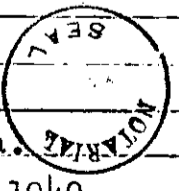
