

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Mary E. Brown

in consideration of the sum of One dollar and the premises above

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said L. A. Forrester

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Highland Township, adjoining lands of S. C. Mills and others and being a part of a sixty two acre tract conveyed to me by ^{E. Inman, Master for Greenville County} and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on a stone on the S. C. Mills line witnessed by large pine and runs thence S. 81- $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 23.14 chains to a stone; thence S. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.95 chains to a stone on branch; (this is the ommitted line); thence S. 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 30.37 chains to a stone, Mills corner thence N. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 14.50 chains to the beginning corner, and containing Thirteen and Twenty Nine one-hundredths (13.29) acres, more or less.
