(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
L. G. Balle, W. C. Beacham, J. D. Harris, J. F. McKelvey and B. L. Rushing, as Trustees of the Greenville District, Upper South Carolina Conference, Methodist Episcopal Church, South, their successors in office and assigns:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the South side of East Earle Street, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11 of Section G, on plat of Stone Land Company property, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book A, pages 337-345, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of East Earle Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 11, said pin also being 240 feet East from the Southeast corner of the intersection of Bennett and East Earle Streets, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 9, S. 18-30 W. 206.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 12, S. 71-20 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 13; thence with the line of Lot No. 13, N. 18-30 E. 206.5 feet to an iron pin on the South side of East Earle Street; thence with the South side of East Earle Street, N. 71-20 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
