(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Henry Aiken, W. B. Aiken, and Arthur Aiken

All our right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing one hundred and seventy-four (174) acres, more or less, and bounded by land of Jefferson Howard, James Gosnell R. E. Johnson, Mrs. Margaret Ballew and others, said tract consisting of four (4) tracts as follows; one tract containing one hundred (100) acres, one tract containing sixty (60) acres; one tract containing twelve (12) acres; and one tract containing two (2) acres; mill site; this being the same tract of land purchased by J. L. Aiken from E. Inman, Master, as appears by deed dated July 8, 1931 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 162, page 161.

Also all that tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid, known as part of the land conveyed to J. B. Thompson by deed from J. W. Gray, Master, and a part of Lot No. 12 in the division of Gabe Thompson Estate, adjoining lands of J. B. Thompson, and William Thompson, and others.

Beginning on an iron pin on the White Horse Road, thence running N. 3/4 W. 1.10 to fork of road; thence with Finley Bridge Road N. 55 W. S. 25 to stake; thence S. 51 3/4 W. 12.50 to a stake on branch; thence up said branch to stake on branch; thence N. 51 3/4 E. 12.00 to the beginning corner, and containing 10 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. L. Aiken by Jessie Dickerson by deed dated February 18, 1932 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 161, page 395.

Also all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Graceland Cemetery, in Greenville County, State of S. C., designated as lot 440, Section 8, containing 200 square feet, more or less. This being the same lot of land deeded to A. Ramseur by G. B. Goodlett and W. H. Griffin under date of August 17, 1917 yet to be recorded. See deed in Vol. 46, page 271. This deed is subject to the rules and regulations of the Graceland Cemetery Association, as stated in its deed bearing date July 5, 1916, recorded July 22, 1916, in Vol. 29, page 295.
