SEPARATION AGREEMENT.

Whereas, in consideration of certain differences the parties hereto have concluded that it is impracticable for them to longer live together as husband and wife and

AGREED: That party of the first part, in consideration of the receiprocal agreement on the party of party of the second part, does hereby release and absolve party of the second part from all obligations, duties and responsibilities, growing out of said marriage; and likewise, party of the second part, in consideration of the release by party of the first part, as herein above stated, does hereby release and absolve party of the first part from all duties, responsibilities and obligations growing out of said marriage relationship, and especially does party of the second part, in consideration of the facts and circumstances herein above stated, release and absolve party of the first part from all claims of support to which he might otherwise be subject, except for this agreement; and

It is further mutually agreed, in consideration of the matters hereinabove set forth, that each of the parties hereto shall in nowise molest or interfere in anyway with the other, but each of the above parties is free to do as he or she may set fit.
