(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. B. McIntosh and Grace S. McIntosh, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in what is known as "Park Place", near the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat of said Park Place, which plat is recorded in Plat Book "A", at page 119, to wit: Beginning at a stake in lot 18, on the east side of Second Avenue, 37½ feet from the corner of Lot 16, and running thence along said Avenue N. 0. 17 E. 37½ feet to a stake in lot 20; thence across lot 20, about S. 89-45 E. 150 feet to a stake on 10 foot alley; thence along said alley about S. 0.17 W. 75 feet to a stake corner of lot 16; th N. 89-45 W. 50 ft., th. N. 0.17 E. 37½ ft.; thence along line of lot conveyed to T. E. Pike, about N. 89.45 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, and being known as the major portion of lot 18 and one half of lot 20 in Block "F", on the above named plat. See deed Vol. 70, page 584.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township County and State aforesaid, in Park Place, near the City of Greenville and being a portion of lot #18 in Block "F" on the plat recorded in Plat Book "A", at page 119.

Said lot having a frontage of 37½ feet on Second Avenue, and a depth of 100 feet; this is a portion of the lot of land conveyed to me by W. F. Cooper, See Vol. 70, page 584. The above two parcels are all of lot no. 18 and one half of lot No. 20.
