TITLE TO REALESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.

WHEREAS, L. L. Bridges on the 31 day of August, 1925, executed and delivered to the City of Greenville, S. C., a right-of-way and easement over all or part of the real estate hereinafter described, and said agreement and easement has been duly recorded in Deed Book, 120, page 7, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville now proposes to construct a second pipe line along and over said lands as permitted under the terms of the said easement agreement hereto-fore given, and

WHEREAS, it is desired by this supplemental agreement to specify the locating of said second pipe line to be laid and to fix the damage, if any, for such additional rights of use.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, the undersigned of the State and County aforesaid, the owner of the property below described, for and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars to me in hand paid by the City of Greenville, S. C., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby release and discharge the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, from all claims for damage of any nature whatsoever by reason of the installation and construction of said second pipe line which is to be laid so that the center line thereof will not be further than 35 feet from the center line of the old pipe line. The compensation hereinbefore named constitutes payment for all privileges and rights hereby granted and for all damages arising from the installation and construction of said second pipe line along and over the lands hereinafter described.

A tract of land situated in Bates Township, said County and State, and bounded by lands of Esley Batson and Henry Guest on the north; Wesley Batson on the east by Cleve Epps on the south; and by North Saluda River on the west.

There in no mortgage on this property.

To Have and to hold all and singular the rights and privileges hereby granted and released to the City of Greenville, its successors and assigns forever.

I hereby agree to release and give to the City of Greenville, S. C. actual physical possession of the above described premises not later than the 15th day of December, 1938.
