All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina about 2½ miles North of the City of Greenville in Section known as Sans Souci Annex as shown on plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 29, known and designated as Lots Nos. 29 and 30, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a pin on the West side of Interurban Ave. 100 feet from the intersection of Duke Street and running thence N. 42-20 W. 157.5 feet to a pin on an alley; thence with said alley, N. 42-40 E. 100 feet to a pin, joint corners with lot No. 31, S. 42-20 E. 157.5 feet to pin on Interurban Avenue; thence with said Interurban Avenue, S. 42-20 W. 100 feet to the beginning point. Being the same land conveyed to me by Paul C. Davis by deed dated August 8th, 1928, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. 136 at page 326.

As part of the consideration the grantee assumes and agrees to pay a certain mortgage covering the above described premises executed by the grantor to Loui Greet in the sum of \$500.00 together with all interest on account of said mortgage, from its date.
