(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Robert Reubin Bishop, his heirs and assigns forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 28, 29 and 30, in a subdivision known as East Lynne, as shown by plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, page 195, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Lowndes Hill road, joint corner of Lots 30 and 31, which point is 100 feet west of the intersection of Lindsay avenue with Lowndes Hill road, and running thence along the joint line of said lots 30 and 31, S. 9-1/4 E. 164.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-02 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 27 and 28; thence along the joint line of said lots 27 and 28, N. 9-1/4 W. 164 feet to an iron pin on Lowndes Hill Road; thence along the line of said Lowndes Hill road, N. 80-43 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner. Lots Nos. 28 and 29 were conveyed to me by Laurens Road Development Co. by deed dated Sept. 5, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 172, page 114, and Lot No. 30 was conveyed to me by Laurens Road Development Co. by deed dated July 9, 1934, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 172, page 141."
