## TITLE TO REALESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA )
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE )

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Grantors hereof, all of said County and State, for and in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Sixty Five Dollars to us in hand paid by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors, and assigns, the right, privileges and easement to go in and upon that tract of land, situate in Greenville Township, in said County and State, bounded by lands of: River Side road on the North, McAllisters Estate on the east, Reedy River and Union Bleachery on the south.

To construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a pipe line, air vents, blow-off connections, manholes and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line, all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operations of same.

It is understood and agreed that the right-of-way to be used under this contract is throughout the above property which is approximately three hundred and twenty five feet. (325 ft.) in length, and it is further understood and agreed that the City shall have a right to use a strip of land fifty feet in width across said premises only during the installation of said pipe line. The location of said pipe line is to be approximately along the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ line as located and staked out by the engineers, subject to a variation of not exceeding 5 feet either way.

In the use of said 50 feet during construction, it is understood that the contractors will use a strip 20 feet in width along the Eastern side of the center line of the pipe line to be laid, and a strip 30 feet in width along the Western side thereof. The right to use said entire 50 feet during construction shall terminate on the acceptance of the pipe line by the City of Greenville, S. C.

PROVIDED: All timber removed from the right-of-way is cut into four feet lengths, split into cord wood, stacked and all without expense to grantors and to belong to them; the words "Pipe line" wherever occurring herein shall mean ONE PIPE LINE; the words "To Enter upon said premises" wherever occurring herein shall mean, in, over and on the area between the outer lines of the said right-of-way, and only from roads or highways designated by H. Y. Thackston.

It is further understood that the owner is to have the same privileges and rights to cultivate and use this right-of-way strip of land as it had prior to this agreement, provided, such use the reof will not interfere with the proper operation and maintenance of this line.

It is further agreed that in case of future damages to property or crop, due from an accident on said pipe line, that the City of Greenville shall pay all damages.

The payment above specified covers compensation for the easement or right-of-way and also dovers all claims for damages along said right-of-way resulting from construction of the pipe line to be laid.

The undersigned agreed to release and give to the City of Greenville, S. C., actual physical possession of the above described premises not later than the 19 day of May, 1939;
