All that tract of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, contain-
ing 11¼ acres, more or less, known as a part of the John D. Harris place located near the Loss
Swamp Road about eight (8) miles south of Greenville, known and designated as tracts No. 15 and
16 of the property belonging to Mrs. Mary H. Cleveland as shown by a plat made by Wm. A. Hudson,
dated October 21, 1891, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina,
in plat book "H" at pages 203 and 204, and having according to said plat the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on a wild cherry 3x and running thence N. 69½ E. 31.85 chs. to a
stone 3x; thence N. 22½ W. 6.30 chs. to a stone; thence N. 22 W. 5.65 chs. to a sweet gum 3x;
thence N. 22 W. 23.00 chs. to a stone 3x; thence N. 68¼ W. 5.80 chs. to a stone 3x; thence S.
50 W. 31.90 chs. to a stone 3x; thence S. 28½ E. 12.00 chs. to a stone 3x; thence S. 27 E. 16.70
chs. to the beginning corner.
