Kennedy, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot, piece or parcel of land, lying, being and situate near the Corporate limits of the Town of Fountain Inn, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, on the West side of Durban Church road, containing Thirty (30) acres, more or less, known as the home place of W. T. Parks, now deceased, bounded now or formerly by lands of John Edwards estate, Hattie Thackston, the Durban Church Road, and others, and being the same tract of land devised to me by my father, W. T. Parks; reserving unto myself the right to the use and occupation of said lands during my natural live provided, I pay the taxes and insurance premiums on full fire and tornado accoverage over the buildings on said property when due, and keep the same in repair, otherwise my use and occupation of same to cease.
