TITLE TO REALESTATE

Patterson all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, in Greenville County and Township, about three miles northwestward from Greenville Court House, having the following metes and bounds, according to a survey and sketch made by R.E.
