All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Grove Township  
County and state aforesaid and more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the old road leading from Reddy fork church to Burdetts  
Mill, corner of Henderson and Woodside land, and running thence N. 13 3/4 W. 6.38 to bend in  
old road, thence N. 14 1/2 W. 4.53 to iron pin; thence by a new line S. 79 1/2 E. 12.90 to an iron  
pin, thence N. 81 1/2 E. 8.50 to an iron pin thence N. 6 1/2 E. 13.00 to an iron pin on Griffin's  
line, thence along said line S. 64 1/2 E. 15.80 to a stone, thence along Paynes line S. 3 1/4 E.  
9.60 to stone at Woodside corner, thence along his line S. 80 W. 34.85 to the beginning corner
