TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, R. N. Smith County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against W. D. Workman, The Etowah Realty Co., Lakeside Realty Corporation and Marsmen, Inc. defaulting taxpayers of said County, strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to Levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said Marsmen, Inc. et al, tax defaulters, the sum of Forty Five & 79/100 dollars including the penalties on said tax executions for the years 1926 through 1934 together with charges and costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, by virtue and authority of said warrants W. A. Hopkins the then delinquent tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 16th day of June 1939 seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of July 1936 during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to Marsmen, Inc. and their heirs and assigns, the purchasers, hereinafter known as "grantees", and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Forty five & 79/100 dollars and gave a receipt for said purchase money to them; and

WHEREAS, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayers, or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, M. L. Ashmore Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Forty five & 79/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantees, Marsmen, Inc. have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantees, Marsmen, Inc their successors and assigns:

All those lots or parcels of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, and State of South Carolina known as lots numbers 3, 12, 14, 30, 67, and 69 of the Paris-Piney Park subdivision, plat of which is recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said Marsmen, Inc. their successors and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
