Gilreath of the District and State aforesaid for and in the consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to me paid by Hampshire Brown of the same place have bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said Hampshire Brown a certain piece or parcel of land containing eight acres more or less, situate, lying, and being in the State and District aforesaid it being a part of the tract on which I now live, beginning at a red oak near the spring on the William Thomas line running thence S. 22 / E. 7 chains to the road leading to pine log ford on Enoree River thence along said road North East 13 chains to pine in forks of said road, and road leading to William Thomas' place thence along road leading to William Thomas place to said Thomas' line, thence along said line to the beginning corner, together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments, appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Hampshire Brown his heirs, and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, and my administrators to warrant, and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Hampshire Brown, his heirs, and assigns against myself, my heirs, and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the said or any part thereof.
