The compensation hereinbefore: named constitutes payment for all privileges and rights hereby granted and for all damages arising from the installation and construction of said second pipe line along and over the lands hereinafter described.

A tract of land situated in Cleveland Township, said County and State, and bounded by lands of Ab McJunkin on the North, by lands of O. W. Hardin on the East, by lands of O. W. Hardin, T. O. Lawton and others on the South and by lands of Saluda Land and Lumber Co., and others on the West, and being known as the Lawton Lake property. The second pipe line has already been laid.
