Lots Nos. 44, 78, 79, and 80 of the W. E. Dill Estate according to plat thereof made by S. C. Moon, C. S., April, 1940, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, page 199, said property located near the Super Highway about two miles west of the town of Greer, S. C. Lot 44 above set forth was deeded to John Suber by W. E. Dill, deceased, during his life time, but the courses and distances of said lot originally sold were necessarily changed and a number given it in order to perfect said plat above mentioned, for which reason said lot is included in this deed.
