NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, M. L. Ashmore Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Eighty one & 96/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantees, The Forfeited Land Commission have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantees, The Forfieted Land Commission their successors and assigns:

All those certain pieces, parcels and lots of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the Eastern boundry of the City of Greenville, in a subdivision known as Jefferson Heights and being known and designated according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", page 34 and 35 as lots numbers, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11 and 16, reference to said plat being made for a more complete description of said lots.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,

To have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said The Forfeited Land Commission their successors and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
