All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a stone corner at the southwest corner of the school property: thence
N. 24 E. 227.3 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 34½ E. 400 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 41 E.
335 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34½ W. along the school property line to the beginning corner.
