out of the deed, but the within described lots, having been received as part payment for Lot
No. 7, Sylvania Avenue, are owned by C. M. Gaffney, as Trustee under the terms and conditions as set out in the aforesaid deed of Annie F. Zimmie to C. M. Gaffney, Trustee as recorded in
