LEASE

THIS INDENTURE, BETWEEN Mrs. N. Sue Simpson the Lessor and Tom Gambrell, the Lessee, witnesseth: That the Lessor agrees to lease to the Lessee the tract of land situate in said County, containing 51 acres, known as the N. Sue Simpson Place.

All cultivatable land except patch on south side of my dwelling, garden, orchard, and patch behind old service station extending on north side to main driveway. Place in Gantt Township, Greenville County, for agricultural purposes.
