All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in the City of Greenville, at the northwest intersection of Pendleton Street and North Calhoun Street, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Pendleton Street and North Calhoun Street, and running thence in a westerly direction along Pendleton Street 91 feet to a stake at the corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Bessie S.
