which may render neighboring property less desirable for residential purposes.
2. No residence (other than outbuildings appurtenant to dwelling) costing less than Ten
Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars shall be erected thereon prior to January 1, 1986.
3. The grantor reserves to itself and its successors the right to the placing, maintain-
ing, repairing and replacing of gas, water, and sewer pipes, telephone, telegraph, light and I
time without compensation to any lot owner; except that the premises shall be left in as good
dition as before.
4. No surface closet or cesspool shall ever be used on said lot; but only septic tanks of
other sanitary sewers and all occupants of said lot shall be governed by such reliable sanitar
rules and regulations as may be adopted from time to time by a majority of the owners of lots
ins aid Forest Hills.
5. The said lot shall not be recut and only one dwelling shall be erected thereon.
