"All that piece, parcel or lot of land known as Lot No. 3 of the DeCamp Estate, lying and being and situate on Townes Street, in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, beginning at the corner now or formerly owned by Mrs. M. E. Hutchinson's lot and running N. 15 1/2 E. 75 feet with Townes Street to a stake corner of M. H. Dawson's lot; thence N. 66 1/2 W. 110 feet to a stake; thence S. 15 1/2 W. 75 feet to a stake; thence S. 66 1/2 E. 110 feet to beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Christian Hahn by deed dated June 9, 1891, and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book YY, page 54."

"Also: All that certain lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Central Ave. and known and designated as part of Lot No. 4 of the DeCamp Estate and described as follows: Beginning at the corner of M. H. Dawson lot and running in a westerly direction along Central Ave. 40 feet; thence in a southerly direction, parallel with Townes Street, 150 feet; thence in an easterly direction and parallel with Central Ave. 40 feet to corner of Lot No. 3 of said Estate; thence in a northerly direction and parallel with Townes Street 150 feet to the point of beginning and being the same lot conveyed to me by Christian Hahn by deed dated August 10, 1891, and recorded in Deed Book YY, page 458."
