CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of Southern Bleachery & Print Works Athletic Association

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 30th day of September, 1940, A. D., file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated. or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the The Greenville News, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, That said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed: FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is SOUTHERN BLEACHERY & PRINT WORKS ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Taylors, S. C.

FOURTH. The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to promote athletics and to enlarge and increase opportunities for wholesome recreation; and to have and exercise and all powers necessary or incident to the carrying out of these purposes, and such powers as are generally conferred upon corporations of this character.

Blackwell, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 158, Article III, Code of 1932, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 158, Article III, Code of 1932, and Acts amendatory thereto.

GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this 30th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty and in the one hundred and forty-sixty-fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
