(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Clyde B. Dunlap, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 8, of the Douglass property, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 126, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Highland (or Highlawn) Avenue, at the joint corner of Lots 8 and 9, which point is 143.6 feet east of the southeast corner of the intersection of said Highland Avenue with Worth Street, and running thence along the south side of Highland Avenue, S. 79-10 E. 71.8 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 10-50 W. 137.15 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-24 W. 71.8 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 8 and 9; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 10-50 E. 137.38 feet to the beginning corner on Highland Avenue. 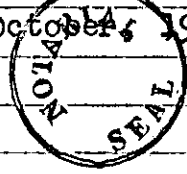
