at and before the sealing of these presents by S. Slater & Sons, Inc., a corporation chartered under the laws of  
The State of Delaware

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
S. Slater & Sons, Inc., its Successors and Assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the East side of Webster Street,  
in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of  
South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 29 of Block D, as shown on a plat of  
the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, on July  
10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book  
K, at pages 63, 64 and 65 and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds,  
to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Webster Street, joint front corner of  
Lots No. 29 and 30 of Block D, whcih iron pin is 215 feet North of the Northeast corner of the  
intersection of Webster and Edison Streets, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 30,  
N. 87-26 E. 125 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 3 and 4 of Block D; thence  
with the rear line of Lot No. 4, N. 2-34 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots No.  
4, 5, 28 and 29; thence with the line of Lot No. 28, S. 87-26 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on  
the East side of Webster Street; thence with Webster Street, S. 2-34 E. 70 feet to the be-  
ginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., dated  
October 1, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deeds  
Volume 227, page 31, and this deed is given in full satisfaction and payment of that mortgage  
executed by me to S. Slater & Sons, Inc., for One Thousand Seventy-five and No/100 (\$1,075.00)  
Dollars, dated October 1, 1940, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,  
S. C., in Mortgages Volume 296, at page 35.
