known and designated as Lots Nos. 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, and 32, as shown on a plat of the T. W. Dill, Estate made by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, October, 1940, said plat recorded in the office of R. M. C. for said County and State, said lots Nos. 26, 27, 28, and 29 fronting each 50 feet on the south side of the Super Highway, and running back in parallel lines to a depth of 225 feet, and said lots Nos. 30, 31 and 32, each fronting on the south side of said Super Highway 50 feet, and each running back in parallel lines to a depth of 200 feet, said lots being situated about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer.
