known and designated as Lots Nos. 5 and 6 as shown on a plat of the T. W. Dill Estate made by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, October, 1940, said plat recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for said County and State, said lots fronting 50 feet each on the north side of the Super Highway about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer, and running back in a northerly direction in parallel lines to a depth of 225 feet, being bounded on the north by lot 19, on the east by lot 7, on the south by said Super Highway, and on the west by lot 4.

The 40-acre tract from which the said lots were cut was willed by Tandy Walker Dill to grantors and Brooks Dill, the interest of Brooks Dill having been deeded to grantors by E. Inman Master.
