Moon, Surveyor, October 1940, said plat recorded in office of the RMC for said County and State, said lot 17 containing 2.1 acres, measuring 500 feet on the west side of a new road running north from the Super Highway and known as Dill Avenue, and being about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer; said lot 18 immediately west of lot 17, and contains 1.75 acres; said lot 19 lies immediately west of the said lot 18, and contains 6/10 ths. of an acre; and lot 20 is in the approximate shape of a triangle.
