known and designated as Lots Nos. 22 and 23 as shown on a plat of the T. W. Dill Estate made by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, October, 1940, said plat recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., each of said lots fronting 50 feet on the south side of the Super Highway about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer, and running back in parallel lines to a depth of 225 feet.
