has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Fred H. Massey

All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land known and designated as Lots Nos. 57 and 58 of the Survey of Dukeland Park, property of Colonia Company, made by Dalton & Neves, June 1940, and recorded in Plat Book "J", Pages 220 and 221, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North-Western side of Dukeland Drive, said iron pin being 316.6 ft. from the intersection of Dukeland Drive with McMakin Drive and running thence N. 35.42 W. 236 ft. to an iron pin on Langston Creek; thence along the meanderings of Langston Creek N. 88.28 E. 121 ft. to iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57; thence along the line of Lots Nos. 56 and 57 S. 35.42 E. 168 ft. to iron pin on Dukeland Drive; thence along the North-Western side of Dukeland Drive S. 54.18 W. 100 ft. to the point of beginning.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his

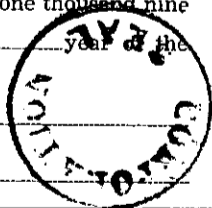
heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
