KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Judson Mills

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Seventy-five and no/100 (\$1,075.00)- DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto James M. Bishop, his heirs

and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the north side of Seventh Street, in Section No. 4 of Judson Mills Village, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 46 as shown on a plat of Section No. 4 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, January 1941, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 75 and 76, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of Seventh Street and Neubert Avenue, and running thence with the north side of Seventh Street S. 88-10 W. 53.7 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots No. 46 and 47; thence with the line of Lot No. 47, N. 1-42 W. 122.65 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 78, N. 88-16 E. 63.7 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Neubert Avenue; thence with the west side of Neubert Avenue S. 1-42 E. 112.3 feet to an iron pin on said Avenue; thence continuing with the curve of Neubert Avenue S. 43-14 W. 14.2 feet to the beginning corner.
