

## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all of the creditors having claim or claims against either of both of said corporations be and are hereby restrained and enjoined from commencing, prosecuting or maintaining any action at law or in equity for the enforcement of any claims, or demands against the said Carolina Industrial Securities Corporation or the said C. R. Bealle & Co., Inc., and that all claims or demands of any persons whomsoever shall be by petition to this court in this cause.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said defendant Corporations, or either of them or any parties to this action, having any assets belonging to either or both of said corporations are hereby required to turn over to Claude M. Epps all of said assets of either or both of said Corporations, which are in their hands or under their control.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each and all of said defendants herein are required by the terms of this order to file forthwith with the said Claude M. Epps, Receiver herein, complete and true list and inventory of all assets now held by either of them as well as a true list and inventory of all liabilities now due by either or any of them, said inventory and list to be furnished within forty eight hours after service of this order upon them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the defendants, and each of them, are hereby enjoined and restrained from interfering with, or in any way hampering the conduct of the Receiver in the administration of this Receivership; and each and every defendant herein and all other persons are enjoined, pendente lite from moving away any of the personal property, books or account, records, and any other property of the said Corporations from the present locations, except that the same shall be turned over to the receiver upon his request.
