I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, **J. W. Norwood, Jr., as Attorney**

on or about the **7th** day of **May** in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and **forty** exhibited **his** complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against **Joseph M. Hunt, Individually and as Administrator of the Estate of Willie Mae (G.) Hunt, deceased, et al.**

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the **29th** day of **May**, 19**40**, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of **One Hundred (\$100.00)** Dollars,

to me paid by the said **J. W. Norwood, Jr.**

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said **J. W. Norwood, Jr.**

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County and State of South Carolina on the Jones Gap Road (or Geer Highway) and in the Northwestern section of the Town of Marietta and Beaverdam Branch, waters of North Saluda River, adjoining lands formerly owned by Mrs. Lizzie Cleveland and Fritchett and fronting on said Jones Gap Road, containing ten (10) acres more or less."
