Beginning on the double poplars and running thence N. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 12.05 to a stone; thence S. 70 E. 9.50 to a small Hickory; thence S. 59 E. 8.20 to a stone; thence N. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 14.75 to a stone; thence N. 43 E. 2.80 to a stone; thence S. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.60 to a stone; thence S. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 7.10 to a stake; thence S. 10 E. 15.75 to a stone on top of rock cliff; thence S. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.35 to a stake; thence N. 53 W. 11.20 to a dogwood; thence N. 38 W. 4.10 to chestnut oak stump; thence S. 82 W. 13.50 to a maple; thence N. 77 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.10 to a stake; thence N. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 8.00 to a stake; thence N. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 7.85 to a stone on the branch; thence up said branch N. 55 W. 10.70 to the double poplar, the beginning corner, containing sixty five acres more or less.
