KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That R. W. Arrington,

In consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations,

to me sold by Charles H. Cely.In the State aforesaid, the parties hereto have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Charles H. Cely, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Augusta Court, joint corner of Lots Nos. 57 and 58, and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 59-22 E. 164.8 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 69; thence with line of said lot N. 51-20 E. 59.83 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 56; thence with line of said lot N. 39-24 W. 160.4 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Court; thence with said Augusta Court S. 55-30 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described lot is known and designated as Lot No. 57 in Block D of Augusta Court as shown on a plat thereof made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, April, 1923, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 124, reference to said plat being hereby made for a more complete description.

The grantee assumes payment of the 1941 State and County taxes.

Nevertheless, upon the following conditions, however, which conditions are part of the consideration for this deed and are expressly for the benefit of all owners of lots as shown on said plat above referred to, to wit: (1) No dwelling shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalk than 30 feet. (2) The facing of the lots as shown on said plat shall be strictly adhered to, however, more than one lot may be used for the purpose of erecting a dwelling. (3) The property herein conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to Negroes or person having any percentage of Negro blood. (4) No out-building shall be erected nearer to the abutting side-walk than forty (40) feet.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Malville C. Westervelt, as Trustee, on the 17th day of May, 1923, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 65, Page 560.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Charles H. Cely, his

heirs, and assigns, forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles H. Cely, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
